1. **Exchange a coat or robe.** Matthew 27:28, Colossians 3:10
Revelation 3:5, 1 Samuel 18:1–4, Isaiah 61:10.
2. **Exchange a belt, or weapons (usually a scabbard)**
Exodus 12:11, Ephesians 6:14,
3. **Cut the Covenant,** Genesis 15:9, John 19:34-37,
4. **Raise the right arm and mix blood,** they both make a cut in the palm
of their hands, John 14:20 Matthew 26:28, John 6:34 Ref.
Luke 13:1, Leviticus 17:10
5. **Making a scar.** Genesis 19:10, Genesis 17:10 Ref. Romans 2:29,
Exodus 31:13
6. **Exchange names,** Genesis 32:22–31 Ref. Revelation 2:17
7. **Give the covenant terms** Exodus 20, Deuteronomy 5 Ref.
John 16:23, John 14:14 Ref. John 14:15,
8. **You eat a memorial meal together.** Matthew 26:26, Revelation 19:9

9. **Then, you plant a memorial tree together.** Genesis 21:33 Acts 5:29

10. **Call one another friend.** John 15:13-14
